Two homes are currently being built.



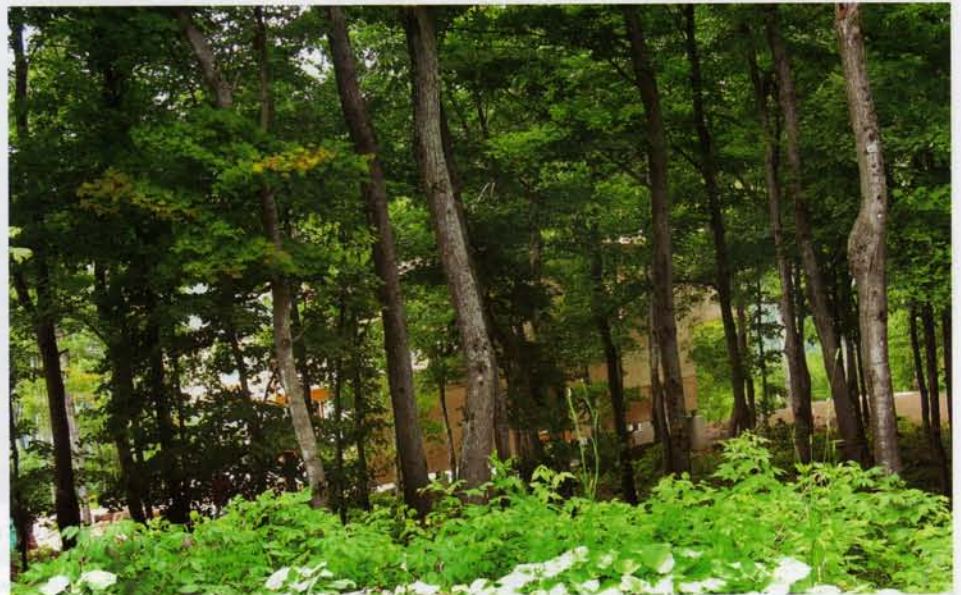
